Must be employed by an Alabama licensed Limited Elevator Contractor to receive this license. The following documents must accompany this application:

- 1.) A certificate of training or equivalent from the manufacturer of each type of equipment installed, altered, serviced, replaced or maintained.
- 2.) Check or money order, payable to the Alabama Department of Workforce in the amount of:
\$100.00 (initial and renewal prior to expiration date) or
\$125.00 (renewal of an expired license within one year of expiration date).
